

FRED'S PHARMACY PUBLIC NOTICE

On August 20, 2016, a laptop was stolen from a trusted employee's car, which was parked at home in what normally is considered a safe, residential neighborhood. After extensive investigation, Fred's Pharmacy determined that some customers' full names and telephone numbers were stored on the laptop for administrative, work-related purposes. Some of these customers' prescription medication(s) information was stored as well. The laptop was password protected. **Social security numbers, credit card information and other financial information were NOT stored on the laptop.**

Please note that this incident did NOT affect all Fred's customers. Notice letters were mailed on or about September 29, 2016 to the last known address of all individuals who were affected. Some letters were returned due to an incorrect address.

Fred's was notified of this incident on August 20, 2016 and immediately reported it to police. Area pawn shops were alerted and offered a reward for the return of the laptop. Fred's has **NOT** received any report from anyone that customer information is actually being used inappropriately, but customers are advised, as always for precautionary reasons, to carefully monitor any credit-related reports and accounts, and to please report any problems immediately to local police or to Fred's.
